

YOUR ULTIMATE HOME Spring Cleaning Checklist

General

- O Change batteries for smoke alarm & carbon monoxide detectors
- Replace air filters
- O Clean light fixtures & fans
- O Clean baseboards
- Replace lightbulbs
- O Sanitize door handles & light switches
- O Clean air vents
- O Shampoo rugs and carpets
- O Dust blinds and clean curtains
- O Dust picture frames

Kitchen

- O Vacuum/sweep/mop floors
- O Put clean dishes away
- O Clean dirty dishes
- O Clean the inside/outside of dishwasher
- O Throw away old sponges/wash reusable sponges
- O Clean sink (including the faucet)
- O Wipe down countertops
- O Clean the inside/outside of oven
- O Wipe down stove and burner grates
- O Clean the inside/outside of microwave
- O Remove old food from refrigerator/freezer
- O Clean the inside/outside of refrigerator/freezer
- O Clean the refrigerator/freezer seal
- O Remove old food from pantry
- O Wipe down cabinets & backsplash
- O Wipe down the inside of drawers
- O Organize and remove clutter from cabinets and drawers
- O Remove clutter from countertops
- O Wash kitchen mats
- O Clean your toaster's crumb tray
- Wipe down countertop appliances (rice cooker, coffee machine, kettle, etc.)

Bathrooms

- O Clean the inside/outside of toilet
 - Dust surfaces
- O Wipe down countertops
- O Clean sink, faucet, and handles
- O Clean hand soap tray/bottle
- O Organize and remove clutter from cabinets and drawers
- O Wipe down cabinet exteriors
- O Wipe down the inside of drawers
- O Vaccuum/sweep/mop floors
- O Clean bath mats
- O Wash towels and washcloths
- O Ditch old loofas and razors
- O Clean hairbrush
- O Replace toothbrush
- O Scrub shower/tub and remove grime
- O Clean showerhead and faucet
- O Replace/wash shower liner & curtain
- O Remove trash from wastebasket
- O Wash mirrors
- O Discard expired medication

Bedrooms

- O Dust & Polish Furniture
- Wash sheets, duvet covers, blankets, bed skirts, and pillowcases
- O Vacuum/sweep/mop floors
- O Clean windows
- Organize closet and remove clutter
- O Clean mattress cover
- Remove clutter from bedside table(s)
- O Fluff pillows

Living Room

- O Dust and polish furniture
- O Wash blankets and pillow covers
- O Wash slipcovers
- O Vacuum/sweep/mop floors
- O Dust electronics and sanitize remote controls
- O Clean lampshades
- O Fluff pillows
- Organize TV cabinet or bookshelves

Home Office

- O Dust & Polish Furniture
- O Clean clutter from desk drawers
- Recycle unneeded paperwork
- O Dust and organize bookshelf
- O Dust computer and other electronics
- Sanitize keyboard and mouse
- O Vacuum/sweep/mop floors

Dining Room

- O Clean china in china cabinet
- O Polish silver items
- O Wipe down and/or polish table
- O Clean chairs and cushions
- O Vacuum/sweep/mop floors

Basement/Garage

- O Organize shelves
- O Vacuum/sweep/mop floor
- O Remove clutter
- Open a door and air out the space
- Replace garage door opener batteries
- O Wipe down walls
- O Clean garage door

Laundry/Utility Room

- O Clean inside and outside of washer/dryer
- O Clear dryer vent
- O Remove lint from lint trap
- Organize supplies and remove unneeded bottles
- Wipe walls
- O Sweep and/or mop floors

Stairs/Entry/Hallway

- O Dust and polish furniture
- O Clean vents
- O Vacuum/sweep/mop floors

Kid's Playroom

- O Sanitize plastic toys
- O Dust and polish furniture
- Organize and remove clutter
- O Vacuum/sweep/mop floors
- Wash stuffed animals

Attic

- Reorganize stored items and donate items you don't want anymore
- O Dust/vaccuum/sweep
- O Wash windows if you have them
- O Look for mildew or mold and inspect insulation

Home Exterior

- O Clean window exteriors
- O Rinse outside of home to remove grime (TIP: you may want to avoid using a power washer for this step since it could damage your home. A normal gardening hose can usually get the job done!)
- Remove debris from gutters
- O Check that outside faucets are working
- Clean your chimney
- O Sweep deck clean and give it a rinse

Front & Backyard

- Rake leaves
- O Mow the lawn
- O Lay fresh mulch in flowerbeds and hedge areas
- O Trim tree branches that are too close to your home
- O Reseed spots on your lawn where grass is sparse
- O Pull weeds

Pool

- O Treat the water
- O Change valves & filters
- Remove leaves and other debris
